BLS Party/Event Food Policy

Bishop Leibold School have two official school parties — Christmas and Shrove Tuesday, if an additional event/party is planned and food will be present a Google form must be filled out and sent to the school nurse for approval 2 weeks prior to event.

When requesting food donations:

- 1. ALL food must be peanut free
- 2. All food allergies need to be listed- (if your party/event is in a general space be aware that other students may be present and partake in the food)
- 3. All food labels or pictures of recipes must be sent to the school nurse prior to event. If the item is not approved, it cannot be served
- 4. An allergy safe alternative can be suggested.

At event/party:

- 1. ALL food needs to be served on different dishes, served with separate utensils. (Many times, it is best to serve those with allergies first, to limit cross contamination.)
- 2. ALL food must be served with food safe gloves.

The goal is for each child to be able to enjoy the party, whether that means that there is one allergen-free snack for all students or that there is a snack for the non-allergic students with a comparable snack provided for the students who need it.

All snacks for classes MUST be reviewed by the school nurse. Parents should send label / recipe pictures to homeroom parents, and then the complete list will be sent from homeroom parent to the nurse. If a food is NOT approved or reviewed by nurse, than it CANNOT be served.
