Special singing and speaking parts will be announced this week to those that have not already received them. While a script will be available on stage, students with speaking parts have been asked to write their line(s) on a notecard with the order number in the corner. The script is fairly small and it will be easier to find and read quickly their lines if on a separate card. Students are welcome to memorize their lines, but do not have to.

Performance Grades

As part of the Ohio Music Standards, students will: perform and demonstrate musical elements, develop criteria to evaluate performances of music, and use their recorded performances to form and express opinions. Students will continue to receive a large grade for their performance, as has been done in the past. Students' attendance is mandatory and as it only takes place once a year, other extra curricular activities will not be considered as an excused absence. As a part of their grade for attending a performance and using proper audience etiquette, students are required to stay for the entire performance to receive full credit. For what constitutes as an excused versus unexcused absence, please refer to your school handbook for normal school attendance. For all excused absences students will be given the opportunity to do work to make up the grade. For all unexcused absences students will be given the opportunity to do work to make up 80% of the original grade. An additional 10% will be deducted if proper prior notification was not communicated. Whether excused or unexcused it is imperative that you communicate with me so that students can receive the make up work with ample completion time.
